EXITO BLACK OAT

EXITO is characterized by rapid growth and substantial root development. Japanese oats Exito can add up to 1650 kg of effective organic matter per hectare to the soil when used as a green manure, especially with early sowing. EXITO is NAK certified and free of wild oats.

Japanese oats is a cereal species specifically used for the control of root-lesion nematodes (*Pratylenchus penetrans*). Japanese oats is resistant to *Meloidogyne hapla*, but it is a good host plant for the corn root-knot nematode, *Meloidogyne chitwoodi*.
